

Our children will celebrate diversity in modern Britain. (UW)

As we explore different foods and consider the benefits of a balanced diet we will try recipes from different cultures, customs and countries. Additionally we will be looking at the importance of good oral health and exercise.

Christmas is a focus this term, we will incorporate it into our food topic as well as learning about the importance of the Nativity to Christians.

Personal Social and Emotional (PSED)

Our termly Jigsaw Unit is Celebrating Difference, our planned Equality and Diversity week fits in well with this unit.

We will continue to embed our school values; Kindness, Respect and Resilience.

Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)

We will continue with our weekly singing with Mrs Lauder.
We will demonstrate our creativity in art using food as stimulus or tool for observational drawings, textures in printing and macaroni art.

Our children will be able to grow and prepare their own food. (UW)

We will finish our spring bulb planting adding Tulips in November. We will prepare one of our beds with wild flower seed bombs to encourage pollinators next year.

Our Raspberry patch needs pruning and preparation for the winter. We will be planting some windowsill herbs.

Maths (M)

As we continue to follow White Rose maths the children will develop their understanding of number. We will explore the concept of greater than, less than, more than, fewer than, equal to or the same.

We will be building on our ability to subitise – when you are able to look at a group of objects and realise how many there are without counting. We will be exploring one more and one less of a given number.

Our children will know and use some signs of Makaton (CLL)

We will continue to build upon our recognition and use of Makaton. The children will consolidate signing greetings and we will start to introduce learning their initials to indicate their name.

We will use Makaton to support our Christmas performance singing.

Our children will be confident using a variety of tools. (PD)

We will build on our skills of manipulating a variety of tools confidently in different contexts such as-

- Graters/ safety knives and other cooking utensils to make fruit salad, gingerbread people and other dishes.
- Gardening tools as we prepare our planting site and keep our outside classroom clean.
- Mallets and golf tees as we explore the inside of the pumpkins.

Literacy (L)

Daily Read Write Inc sessions will build upon the children's progress with reading and writing development. Material to support your child at home is located on the Google classroom.

Additional reminders

We will continue to have PE on Mondays and Fridays to develop gross motor skills.
We change reading books on Monday, please sign the link book when the children have read. Don't forget to check Google classroom for monthly home learning challenges and phonics support.

Our children will retell a story using ambitious language. (CLL)

Our Core text this term is 'The Little Red Hen' to support the children's understanding from farm to fork in our food topic. We will also explore 'The Gingerbread Man'
We will immerse ourselves in the texts, using drama, actions, Makaton and repetition with the aim of being able to retell the story in our own words.
