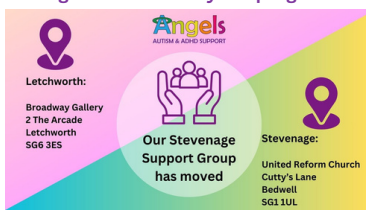
**Weekly online Workshop and Support:
