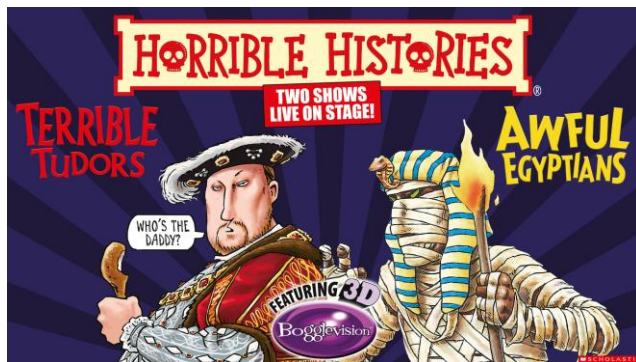


## Horrible Histories – Thu 14th May to Sat 16th May 2026
