Dear parents/carers

We're proposing the introduction of a 20mph speed limit across most of Long Marston to make streets safer and support children walking and cycling to school.

A short online survey is now open at www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/20mph and we welcome your views.

Reducing speeds to 20mph has proven benefits including:

- Improved safety - fewer collisions occur with slower speeds and a person hit at 30mph is five times more likely to be killed than at 20mph
- Healthier communities - slower speeds encourage more walking, scooting and cycling
- Stronger neighbourhoods - calmer roads make public spaces more sociable and welcoming while better supporting children, older people and those with mobility impairments
- Safer pets and wildlife - drivers have more time to stop and avoid animals
