Class 3 – Trip to the Verulamium Museum, St Albans

This term, as part of their History topic, Class 3 will be visiting the **Verulamium Museum in St Albans** on **Monday 31st March 2025**. They will be taking part in a tour and a workshop, plus some time to explore.

The cost of the trip will be **£19.50 per child** and this will cover transport, entrance and workshop. Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough contributions we may have to cancel the trip.

The donations that we will receive will not cover the whole cost of the trip therefore, if you are able to make an additional donation, it would be greatly appreciated.

Goody Bags
