



A Guide to Class 3

Staffing

Mrs Stephenson is the Class teacher with Miss Dell as full time Teaching assistant. They will also have PE with Game On on Thursday afternoons, with specialist coaches.

Reading

Your child must have their reading book in school every day. They are able to change their book when they need a new one and put a sticker on the class chart. When the class get to 100 books there is a class reward, to be decided by the children. They should be reading at home, on average 4 times a week and this needs to be recorded in the home school link book. Parents can help develop their child's reading/comprehension by asking them questions about what they have read and by modelling good reading, including the use of expression.

Library Books

Your child has the opportunity to visit the library on a Friday. This is their chance to change their library book if they wish.

Homework

Children should read at least 4 times a week and this must be recorded in link books. They should also practise their times tables on TTRockstars for a minimum of 5 minutes, 3 times a week. Login details for this will be sent home in September.

Pencil cases

Children must have a school pencil case. These are provided through the school Office. The contents will be replenished as necessary, throughout the year. Please pay for these via the Arbor app.

P.E

PE is on Wednesday and Thursday afternoons. Your child will need to come to school in their PE kit on these days.

Uniform and belongings

Please make sure that your child's clothes and belongings are named, including water bottles. This is particularly helpful if you have bought second-hand uniform which might have a previous child's name in it.
