Dear Parents

Class 5 - Caldecotte Xperience School Journey

We would like to take all the children in Class 5 to **Caldecotte Xperience Outdoor Centre**, in Milton Keynes for their school journey, from **Monday 22nd June to Friday 26th June 2026**. We will be staying in yurts and tepees and meals will be provided by the centre. During our stay the centre provides a range of different activities for us to do. We feel residential trips make an important contribution towards a child's social development, promoting independence and helping to improve organisational skills, hopefully preparing them for the transition to secondary school. We hope you feel your child would benefit from this adventure.

The voluntary contribution will be **£452.00**, which includes all transport, accommodation, food and activities. If not enough voluntary contributions are received, the trip will not go ahead.

We need a commitment from the majority of the class as well as a **deposit of £50.00 by Friday 24th October 2025** and assurance that the full cost of the trip will be met. Consent for your child to attend the trip and payments can be paid on Arbor in the usual way. In addition to the deposit amount the outstanding payment can be made as a one-off payment of **£402** or instalments as set out below:

- £80.40 by 5th January 2026
- £80.40 by 2nd February 2026
- £80.40 by 2nd March 2026
- £80.40 by 6th April 2026
- £80.40 by 5th May 2026

We understand that in the current economic climate, funds can be tight and it will therefore be possible to pay the cost of the trip in instalments. However, if you feel you will be unable to pay all the cost please let us know as soon as possible so we can try to help.

We will provide further information if the initial response is good.
